

# New York Homeschool Reporting

## How New York treats homeschooling

New York is a high-regulation state. File an IHIP (Individualized Home Instruction Plan) and quarterly reports.

## What to keep on file

- Submit a Letter of Intent by July 1 (or within 14 days of starting).
- File an IHIP listing syllabi for each required subject — use the Scope & Sequence PDF.
- Submit 4 quarterly reports — use the Quarterly Progress Report template.
- Annual assessment required (standardized test in alternating years OR written narrative).

## Future Her artifacts that satisfy review

- Scope & Sequence PDF — syllabus / course of study.
- Standards Crosswalk PDF — alignment to ELA, SEL, and life skills.
- Printable Workbook pages — dated student work samples.
- Quarterly Progress Report — narrative + growth indicators.
- Certificates of Completion — end-of-program documentation.
